



The Infirmary is a fascinating 21st century interactive exhibition that combines history, science, art and technology, bringing to life the medical stories of one of England's oldest infirmaries.

Situated within a ward of the former Worcester Royal Infirmary, now part of the University of Worcester's City Campus, the evocative exhibition explores Worcester's medical stories through characters that worked in the building over the past 200 years.

Visit the exhibition to learn about medical practices and technology over the last 200 years, explore memories and occupations, and discover the important role Worcester played in the formation of the British Medical Association.

Tours and private viewings for groups can be arranged at a reasonable cost, and an annual programme of events can be found on leaflets available throughout the city.
